Unit Renovations

The Association has been notified that any renovation except for flooring and paint NOW requires a building permit from the City.

Please be sure that you provide a completed REQUEST FOR UNIT WORK FORM and a copy of the Building Permit to the office prior to any work beginning in your unit.

The property's dumpster is for household trash only—NO CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS can be placed in the dumpster. Talk to the office for disposal alternatives.

To ensure work is not stopped mid-stream, contact the office before any unit remodeling or renovation begins.

Hurricane Season

...began June 1st (although we've already had two named storms!)

Again this year, Florida has provided a "Disaster Tax Holiday" from May 29th to June 4th in which to purchase supplies tax-free. Be sure to check your supplies and prepare for the coming season!

Also, as you return home for the summer, be sure that ALL ITEMS ARE REMOVED FROM YOUR BALCONY. Items left to blow around during a storm may cause damage the common areas or another unit.

You will be charged if a storm approaches & we have to remove items from your balcony.

Also, if you have guests coming to use your unit, please complete a Visitors Information Sheet and provide it to the office prior to your guests' arrival.
